Interlibrary Loan Survey Interpretation... ...from the Library Cooperation Committee

CCML committees have done three interlibrary loan surveys. The first was in 1977 and done by a graduate student at the University of Denver, Sue A. O'Neill. Her fine work set the tone and was partially repeated in 1985 where statistics were gathered for 1981 to 1985. These statistics were reported by the Committee in May, 1986. Also included in the statistical survey were 30 questions about attitude and procedure in relation to interlibrary loan. The third survey is reported here based on the 1990 DOCLINE annual reports.

The 1977 survey was before OCTANET, Mile High Mail, DOCLINE, Tentime, or even use of the CCLS Courier. Newcomers probably would ask how we did it, but we did have the phone, the U.S. mail, and a drop box at the DMS library! The 1985 Survey showed the situation when OCTANET, Mile High Mail, and the Courier were in use. Based on it the first DOCLINE maps were made when we moved over to that system in summer of 1988, using the PHILSOM database as our first SERHOLD data source. 1989 was the group's first full year on DOCLINE with no more use of Tentime for interlibrary loan. This survey of 1990 data, published here for the first time, is the first survey of interlibrary loan activity since we started on DOCLINE.

Accuracy of the first two surveys was hampered by manual reporting. In 1991, using only DOCLINE data, the survey is ignoring OCLC, phone and mail requests, which might be as much as 10% of any given library's activity. However, if the DOCLINE reports are an 85% to 90% sample of all activity, it has a great deal of validity for the group as a whole. The Library Cooperation Committee reviewed the 1986 survey and found that most of the questions were answered to describe what we do now in this area. Therefore, it was decided not to repeat that part of the survey.

These statistics are reported in two parts of this issue of Council Quotes. Tables A-D can be found at the back as they are larger. Figures 1-4 appear in columns on pages 2-5, opposite this discussion of interlibrary loan activity.

Table A shows the Borrower statistics for the whole state, including UCHSC, but excluding non-DOCLINE libraries. For requests not filled or routed on, the Committee has proposed several reasons for the above average figures. Libraries can analyze their position in relation to the average and may decide to remedy the situation. If anyone knows of other reasons why these rejects occur, please send them in to Sara Katsh and the Committee and they will be reported in the next Council Quotes.

As a state, Colorado borrows more than it lends, even when including the high lending activity of UCHSC as a resource library. Within Table A are the statistics for unfilled requests.

Figure 1 shows the percentage of unfilled requests. This figure enables libraries to compare their not-filled rate with other libraries. The committee proposes that there were 3 possible reasons for a high percentage of unfilled requests.

- 1. Citations not verified (INC).
- 2. Requests rejected on basis of cost (CST).
- "Blind" requests (prefixed journal requests or monograph/AV requests).

A library may know that their high unfilled rate is due to only sending no-cost requests. However, if most of the unfilled are due to unverified requests, they might consider changing their procedures.

Recommendations:

Educate your users about the use of the MEDLINE UI. Verify citations that give little info.

Table B shows the Lender statistics for the whole state, including UCHSC, but excluding non-DOCLINE libraries. This table shows all the data available on the DOCLINE annual summary. From this report, 3 figures were extracted.

Figure 2 shows the percentage of the items requested of a library but not filled. The committee saw two reasons for this figure.

- 1. SERHOLD inaccuracies.
- Lenders that charge must reject MÁXCOST=0 requests.

Most libraries don't feel much control over how their holdings are listed in SERHOLD but the Journal Locator Committee is working hard to remedy that situation. If you have a high rejection rate, looking over your list before the next update might be advisable.

Recommendations:

Update holdings annually (required biennially). Remove titles with only scattered holdings or fix them.

Figure 3 shows the percentage of requests removed or not filled due to non-receipt. The committee could think of only one reason.

1. DOCLINE not accessed daily.

Recommendations:

If at all possible, access DOCLINE every day.

In smaller libraries or when libraries are under construction, moving, or generally over-burdened, these figures may be higher.

Figure 4 shows the percentage of requests removed or not filled due to non-action within 4 days. Again there is only one reason for this figure.

1. Requests are receipted but not acted on within 4 days. Recommendations:

If you receipt a request, you must update it (fill or reject).

A high percentage here could have to do with training and/or staff turnover

DOCLINE Routing Table Recommendations

Table C shows Borrowing and Lending within CCML only, excluding UCHSC. These totals are different from Tables A and B because some libraries borrow and lend alot out of state. The main reason for this is participation in other networks such as VALNET or the military. It is, however, a more valid figure to use when comparing lending and borrowing within the group. Table D shows the percent of activity of the whole. From these two tables, "special consideration" libraries were identified.

This survey basically reconfirms that our net lenders are still net lenders and net borrowers are still net borrowers. Of the 22 libraries with the opportunity to be given special consideration due to being a net lender or a library with more than 4% of the total activity, 16 were in that same category in 1985. Of the 7 other libraries, 4 are new to the group and 3 have moved into the statistical group.

Sara Katsh, chair of the committee, contacted all 22 libraries and determined if they wanted to be given special consideration. Some did and some didn't and the results are reflected in the routing table mailed separately from the Council Ouotes in this issue.

The following recommendations incorporate some specific needs voiced by some of the special consideration libraries.

- 1. Move Swedish to Cell 3.
- 2. Move (or keep) Porter to Cell 3 (reiterating last year's request).
- 3. Move (or keep) National Jewish no lower than Cell 3.
- 4. Some other specialty libraries run less risk when placed in earlier cells (e.g., AORN), because they do not have much of the common medical literature. Place AORN in Cell 1.
- 5. If you want to bypass ILL charges, you should put charging libraries in later cells. Most libraries have DML and FIZ in cell 4, partly due to charges of DML but mostly because they are "mini-resource" collections for the state. You could add Children's to that cell, or move it to cell 5, or whatever cell you have Denison in.
- 6. Some libraries are new to DOCLINE since the original tables were done. Boulder Community, Air Force Academy Hospital, Colorado Psychiatric Hospital (Spitz), Ft. Logan Mental Health Center, Jefferson Center for Mental Health, and Community Hospital in Grand Junction have consented to be added. See their LIBIDs on sample routing table.

The enclosed sample routing table is not a prescription. It is but one possible configuration for a Denver courier borrowing library. Your own borrowing patterns could vary significantly. The sample lists all participating CCML

Lenders who experience increased volume should let us know and we will try to make the routing more equitable. Thanks to all the overburdened libraries who offered to "stay put" on the table. Just remember that these changes are not irrevocable. We wish there were such a thing as completely fair system.


Comparisons across the years


It is hard to compare these statistics to 1985 or 1977 because there is a different set of libraries reporting. (UCHSC is not included in these charts.) Ignoring this problem, Chart # 1 reports that the group has increased it's total activity, in-state and out of state, borrowing and lending. The dramatic increase can partially be attributed to the increase in the number of libraries, but not totally, since most of the "new" libraries are smaller.


Chart # 2 takes a "core" of 20 libraries that reported in 1984 and 1985 and also in 1990. Within this group, borrowing is up slightly but the lending increase is marginal.

Chart # 3 reflects a "core" of 11 libraries that have data in 1977. While borrowing is way up in these libraries lending as slacked off.

Further analysis of this data will be done by the committee.
