We have now streamlined the membership renewal process for those who pay by check or means other than PayPal. We will ensure that a person with convenient access (currently Liz Kellermeyer) regularly checks the P.O. Box during the renewal period and notifies the membership chair of any checks. This will allow for quick manual updating of membership status and eliminate the good number of emails we receive from members who have sent a check, yet get an automated reminder from Wild Apricot due to delays in checking the P.O. As of 5/12/2017 we have 58 active members, meaning they have paid their dues for 2016-2017 cycle. 16 memberships have lapsed, meaning they have not renewed in at least two cycles.

Of note are the 6 new student members. We gained these six due to more active outreach specifically targeted at library students.
